Cascade Clamps - Founded in Portland, Oregon in 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company began as a small machine shop hiring only 4 people. Overall sales for that initial year totaled \$60,000. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless steel valves, pipe fittings and various parts. During 5 years of operation, the business had stretched to forty workers and their annual sales volume had risen to three hundred thirty thousand dollars. Now, Cascade is amongst the top international manufacturers in the material handling business.

Design and production of the company's very first hydraulic cylinder allowed this young business to aggressively pursue new business opportunities. All through the final sixty years, the trade of material handling has grown into a very advanced area with Cascade proudly playing a part in its growth. Cascade at the moment continues to grow as the leader supplier of forklift attachments and numerous associated items. The business feels assured in their ability so as to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding client's requirements in the future and remaining aggressive in the world market.

During the nineteen fifties, Cascade began to make, design, and advertise its hydraulic accessories. A new facility was made in 1956, to be able to accommodate all plant offices and operations in Portland, Oregon, which is still the company's present head office. Following 15 years of business, total employees reached one hundred eighty staff and sales had reached almost \$2,300,000.

1959 in Springfield, Huntington Beach a second production facility was built. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's initial transfer into the global world of the material handling industry when the business established interest in England, Australia, and the Netherlands.

The company changed its name to Cascade Corporation in 1964. In the year 1965, Cascade went public with an initial offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. The company has expanded its production facilities within the U.S. with places in Warner Robins, Georgia, Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Huntington Beach. Cascade products are manufactured internationally thanks to numerous subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a new plant was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European command center. This facility is built to be the essential customer service centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and the year 1997 subsequent to buying 5 firms, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the worldwide leader in forks.
